Choose one of the NYCE Levels:



Click Continue.





TO COMPLETE COURSEWARE




Listen to Amber.

Click the play button under her picture.



Click on Go to Dashboard to see the Student Dashboard. Results of quizzes, tests, and writing prompts are located here.

Click on Logout. This will bring you back to the Username and Password screen.




Notice there is a native language translation button (NLT) on the left side of the text as well as an English translation button.

Click Enter.

Each NYCE level has 30 themes listed on the left side. NYCE automatically highlights Theme 1 in each level.

If you click on the flag button, the themes will translate into that language as seen on the left.

The grey scroll bar allows you to move the themes up and down.

On the right, each lesson will teach you English.



Click on a lesson. On the left, click the play button under the video to hear your coach.

On the right, each line is highlighted as the video is being played.

Notice the NLT button available in the chosen language and in English. You can use this as much as needed.



On the bottom left, Key Words are available.

Again, the NLT buttons are available as well as the Voice Analyzer.

Click on the microphone to record and to have your words analyzed.

Click Record to record your words,

Click Stop once you are done.



Click Analyze to receive immediate feedback on your recording. You'll see a **red** X if the recording is wrong or a **green** checkmark if the recording meets the pronunciation standards.




The Progress on the bottom right shows how much is completed for this lesson only.

Also, a Dictionary is available.



Click on the Dictionary pop-up.




When you click on the Dictionary pop-up, the definition appears as well as the part(s) of speech.

THE PRE-QUIZ




The Pre-Quiz is available in all three levels in NYCE. The Pre-Quiz contains 10 questions and can only be taken once.

Click, type or choose your answer.


Then, click on the right arrow button on the top of the page to move to the next question.

Click on your answer.


Click on Check Answer for immediate feedback.

Click on the Writing Prompt module.



Each Writing Prompt gives directions and a sample.

Write in the space provided. Click on the green Submit button in the bottom right corner. There are 5 opportunities to submit. Once submitted, the writing sample is saved.


All submitted writing can be seen in the Student and Teacher Dashboards where the

Then, click on the right arrow button on the top of the page to move to the next question.


